Operations Narrative

December 18, 2019

Golf Greens #s 3,5,9,10,12,13 and 15 were aerified with solid ¼ tines to help reduce compaction. This was necessary to aid in recovering from Dollar Spot. The remainder of the greens will continue to be evaluated and aerfication will be done if necessary. The utmost care is taken to prevent major disruption of the greens so we don't impact the golfers experience in a negative way.

Trees staff has been checking trees adjacent to greens that are causing shading on the green surface to see about scheduling trimming to help create more light and air transfer. This will help dry the green out from moisture that may stay on it too long contributing to fungal growth (Dollar Spot and others)

Irrigation has been off for an extended period of time after our recent rains. We will adjust as necessary.

The course received approximately 3.4" of rain in the last 5 weeks. We had to close the course on November 28th and December 4th due to unplayable conditions. Carts were restricted to cart paths on December 5th and December 9th due to saturated fairways.

Staffing update: no changes

During the 2 week closure of City Hall golf course maintenance staff (City Staff) will be operating normal hours except for Holidays where crews are here from 3:30am-7:30am-12/24 12/25 and 1/1.
